

**Kansas Singletrack Society**  
**Minutes of Meeting**  
**July 12, 2005**

The Kansas Singletrack Society met at Heartland Cycles in Wichita at 7:00pm. Others present: Byron Fick and Terri Morris of Heartland Cycles. Lonnie Cooper called the meeting to order. Introductions were made of members and new members.

Trail Reports

- Santa Fe—no report.
- Horizon—In good shape except for needing some lopping and chain saw work on the Northwoods.
- Winfield Lake—no report.
- Miller's—Is dried out and will need mowed in places. Tim will do before the ride tomorrow night.

Work Days

- Will schedule work days at Horizon after the club ride on July 16<sup>th</sup>. We will need several in order to get it ready for the Tour de Lizard race in September.

Club Rides

- There was extensive discussion about the club ride coming up on July 16<sup>th</sup> in Chautauqua County. It appears most members will be able to attend. The ride will be mostly self supported, but there will be two vehicles out on the course to provide water and a ride if necessary. Ride begins Saturday at 8:00 am at Three Barns near Sedan
- Weekly rides have been held at Millers, on Wednesday evenings at 6:30 pm—now known as “Miller Lite” rides.

Treasurer's Report Lonnie handed out a written report showing income and receipts for 2005. Bank balance was \$1,151.13.

Old Business

- Brochures—Paula reported that suggested changes have been made. Contact phone numbers have been added for each trail. Paula will get prices on printing at various quantities, then check with the board. The board will approve and they can be printed without waiting until the next membership meeting.
- Lyle Eaton Memorial/Raffle—The raffle will be modeled on the one run by OEF, using their rules and materials. Decided to sell \$5 tickets, with a discount for quantity purchased. Paula and Kim will get tickets and get them distributed to members to sell. Need to start selling soon.
- Trail maps—No report.

- Trail signage and marking—Terry Plenert reported he has put up 2 signs at Horizon and will be finishing and erecting more soon. He turned in receipts for reimbursement as approved by the club in an earlier meeting. With the materials purchased to date, more signs can be produced later.
- Colorado Club Ride—Jerry reported that the group would be riding in the Winter Park, Breckenridge and Copper Mountain areas the weekend before Labor Day weekend. A condo can be rented for \$175 a night that will sleep over 20 people. He needs a commitment for who is going by next week, so the arrangements can be made soon. He will post the ride on BikeKansas and ask for commitments.
- October Ride—Syllamo was mentioned. Nothing has been done at this point.

#### New Business

- Other Fundraisers—Paula brought in catalogues showing sales items that the club could sell as a fundraiser. Specialized water bottles and socks were discussed as good ideas.
