Fall River:

Terry Plenert – trail was mowed in the winter, but before we were supposed to spray, the monsoon season set in. The corridor (6 miles) is still open. (trail will be 30 miles when finished). Terry has done some flagging since. The costs for KTC to come down is high because of the size of the equipment. They bring two trucks and two trailers.. so when they do come down, we need to really dedicate a full weekend and manpower. Can average about ¼ mile per day. KTC would like to come down and work for two day intervals. The big equipment has to be run by KTC due to insurance. Plenty of hand work to be done which is what we need to help with.

Santa Fe:

Kevin Smith - We have 1.8 miles done ... could go south of the creek for another 3 miles.
